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SERVICE AGREEMENT

This Contractual Agreement is made on this 15th Day of March 2022 at Chandigarh

BY AND BETWEEN

(AECPL) having its office at plot no.182/9, Industrial Area, Phase - 1, Chandigarh (hereinafter referred to as "First Party" which expression shall, unless contrary to and/or repugnant to the context mean and include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns) through Sh. Paramjeet Singh, Manager of the company to enter into and sign this agreement for and on behalf of the First Party.

WHEREAS the First Party has been duly authorized by Chandigarh Pollution Control Committee, Chandigarh for collection, reception, transportation, storage, treatment and final disposal of Bio Medical Waste of U.T. Chandigarh vide consent no. CCCC/RSBWTF/1237/2019/158/3258 dated 31.01.2019.

WHEREAS the Second Party in compliance of the Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 desired to have services for disposal of their Bio Medical Waste (except liquid Bio Medical Waste) for which the First Party is authorized by Chandigarh Pollution Control Committee, Chandigarh.


NOW THIS AGREEMENT witnessed the following terms & conditions to be performed by both the parties to the agreement.

1. The First Party will require the Second Party's authorized staff/representatives to sign BMW Collection Sheet in acknowledgement of Bio Medical Waste handed over or Bar code system management as and when applicable.
2. The Second Party will ensure proper segregation of Bio Medical Waste generated from its various collection points of departments as per Bio Medical Waste Management Rules 2016.
3. The Second Party undertakes to deliver to the First Party only the segregated Bio Medical Waste in colour coded segregation bags duly labeled as per Schedule IV, signed and tagged. General Waste i.e. MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE IS NOT BE PUT INTO THE COLOR CODED BAGS. For any violation of the Bio Medical Waste Management Rules in this regard, the Second Party shall be exclusively responsible.
4. The First Party will charge the Second Party minimum of Rs.40427/- per month for lifting & transportation charges plus treatment & disposal charges for actual collected bio medical waste @Rs.80/- per kg from their collection points of bio medical waste at their institute.
5. The First Party shall raise the monthly gross total bill of the Bio Medical Waste lifted, transported, treated and disposed off during the tenure of this agreement and the Second Party ensures to clear the payments within 7 days of the receipt of the bill along with acknowledgements of Bio Medical Waste collected from various collection points.
6. The second party shall deduct the GST or Income Tax as applicable from the bills of the first party.
7. The second party shall make the aforesaid deduction as per present rates notified by the Govt. of India however if there is any increase subsequently the same will be affected accordingly.

8. These service charges would be revised after one year or added accordingly in between as and when the implementation of any new rules/guidelines, increase in the added facilities of PU, increase in the cost of fuel, inflation rate or up-gradation of infrastructure by CPCC etc. or minimum average @7% every year.
9. Taxes such as GST or any other tax or charges i.e. parking fee etc. as and when applicable would be charged extra.
10. AECPL will lift & transport the Bio Medical Waste daily basis except declared holidays of Panjab University and Sunday through duly authorized collection vehicle by CPCC for its treatment & disposal as per the prescribed norms.
11. AECPL staff will report/interact with authorized person of Second Party at designated collection end point only.
12. Non-chlorinated segregation bags and white containers would be available with First Party on extra charges.
13. The term of this agreement shall be one year, commencing from the date of 18th March 2022. Thereafter, the agreement may be renewed from time to time on the terms and conditions agreed upon by both parties.
14. AECPL will submit the **Monthly/Annual Report** of the collected Bio Medical Waste from PU to the prescribed authority as per norms.
15. Any force majeure or undue natural calamities like earth quake, heavy fog, rains, floods, riots and other law & order situation etc. beyond human control will not be considered as a lapse on AECPL part to deduct any payment.
16. Both the parties cannot terminate this mandatory/essential facility/Service contract within the intervening period or in any other event at once. The intention of doing so by one party shall be intimated to the other party and CPCC, Chandigarh immediately prior for doing so with a notice in writing by the said party for their records & necessary action to avoid any violation under BMW Rules.
17. No change or modification or waiver of any of the terms of this agreement shall be effective unless agreed to in writing and signed by a duly authorized officer of each of the parties hereto.
18. Neither party shall transfer and/or assign the rights granted under the Contractual Agreement without the prior intimation to and permission of the other party or without obtaining a written undertaking by the proposed assignee/transferee agreeing to assume all said party's obligations and covenants contained herein.
19. Any such notice or communication shall be deemed to have been duly given and served at the date & time of (I) delivery or of first refusal of delivery, if sent by registered mail/speed post or delivered by hand, or (II) either the date sent (if sent during the receiving party's normal business hours) or next succeeding business day, if sent by electronic media.




