

R.O. with the remarks that the Board of Control at its meeting held on 21.7.2017 has recommended the outlines of tests, syllabi and courses of reading for M.Phil Course for the examinations of 2017-18 in which both the semesters i.e. Semester I and II have 12 credits each.

In this regard, Sr. No. 9.1 of the guidelines for the award of M.Phil/Ph.D degree (which are in conformity with U.G.C. Minimum Standards and Procedures for the award of Ph.D. degree) Regulation-2016 is reproduced below:

9.1 The overall minimum credit requirement, including credit for the course work, for the award of M.Phil degree shall not be less than 24 credits. It is clarified that the minimum credits for M.Phil degree is 24 credits, which will include **16 credits for Course Work and 8 for dissertation.**

You are, therefore, requested to send the syllabus of the above said course duly recommended by the Board of Control according to the above guidelines at 'X' so that the uniformity may be maintained with other subjects.
