As per decision of the Syndicate dated 30.05.2020 stated at pre-page, the **Dean, Faculty of Engineering & Technology dated 09.11.2020 has approved the following recommendation of the Board of Studies in Information Technology, dated 24.07.2020 as at 'X' N-2.**

Item 1: To recommend the Scheme & outline of test syllabi for B.E. Information Technology (3rd to 8th Semester) for the batch 2020-2024 in light of recently approved Scheme and Syllabi of B.E. First year for the session 2020-21.

Resolved: The members of the board discussed and approved the scheme and syllabus of B.E. Information Technology (3rd to 8th Semester) for the batch 2020-2024 in light of recently approved Scheme and Syllabi of B.E. First year for the session 2020-21. The scheme and Syllabus of B.E. Information Technology (1st to 8th Semester) for the batch is attached herewith as per **Annexure-'I'**. Keeping in view new NBA guidelines following was discussed and approved by BOS IT:-

- a. Program specific Outcomes (PSOs) prepared by the Program Advisory Committee (PAC) of IT were put up before BOS IT. The PSOs were approved by the BOS IT.
- b. The Course Outcomes (Cos) of subjects (3rd to 8th Semesters) have been modified as per new NBA guidelines. The members discussed and approved the modified Cos for each subject.
- c. Course articulation matrices which show mapping of the Cos, Pos, and PSOs for the subjects were discussed and approved.
